The Board of Road Supervisors of Freedom Twp met at Scotts Friday evening, Nov. 28 for the regular monthly meeting with all of the Board members, Shorb, Rhodes and Scott present. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved. The Supervisors after full consideration enacted an Ordinance laying out and opening the proposed road by resolution an exact copy of which is as follows:

Whereas: Edward A. Scott, William M. Scott and William S. Scott, landowners taxpayers and residents of Freedom Township, on October 31, 1947 presented a petition to the Board of Road Supervisors of Freedom Township, requesting the laying out and opening of a public road in the Township, starting at a point on the north side of Township Rt. No. 326 approximately 40 ft west of the crossing of Marsh Creek by said Rt. No. 326, thence extending through the lands of the petitioners to a point on Township Rt. No. 325; said point of ending being approximately 1605 feet west of the crossing of Marsh Creek by said Rt. No. 325;

Whereas after due notice, a hearing and view on said petition was held on Tuesday, November 18, 1947, at which evidence was given in proof that it is desirable and necessary for public convenience that said road be laid out and no objection whatever to said road has been made.

whereas the Road as surveyed on November 18, 1947, by P. S. Owen, County Surveyor, whose draft of survey, dated October 18, 1947 is attached hereto as part of this ordinance, reveals that very little damage is done to any abutting landowners and to improvements, and all said landowners have executed a release of dower from any claims on account of the laying out and opening of said road.

Now Therefore, the Board of Road Supervisors of Freedom Township, at its regular meeting held on November 28, 1947. after due consideration of the petition, and the evidence of Public Necessity and Convenience, does hereby unanimously resolve and ordain that a Public Road in Freedom Township, 33 feet in width, be laid out, ordained and opened, and it does hereby ordain, lay out and open the same, the center line, points of beginning and ending being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a spike driven on the north side of Township Rt. No. 326, said point of beginning being located 72 ft west from the west bank of Marsh Creek: thence by lands of Edward A. Scott, William I. Scott and William M. Scott, north 5 degrees East, 75 feet to a spike driven 20 feet east of a telephone pole; thence through lands of the same, north  $64\frac{3}{4}$  degrees west, 977.2 feet to a spike; thence through lands of William I. Scott and William M. Scott, north  $52\frac{1}{4}$  degrees west, 260.5 feet to a spike; thence through the same, north  $59\frac{1}{2}$  degrees west, crossing a small unnamed stream, 221.3 feet to a spike; thence through same, north  $29\frac{1}{4}$  degrees west, 311.8 feet to a spike, thence through same, north  $25\frac{1}{2}$  degrees west, 1009 feet to a spike, thence through same north  $28\frac{3}{4}$  degrees west, 341.2 feet to a point being 1605 feet west of the Marsh Creek crossing of Township Rt. No. 325;

And it is further resolved that report of the above action and proceedings, together with a draft of survey of said road, shall be forthwith prepared and filed in the office of the Clerk of the Quarter Sessions Courts of Adams County; and that the Secretary-Treasurer of



the Board shall cause to be immediately prepared and posted in conspicuous places, at least five hand bills, one at the beginning and one at the end of said road, one at a conspicuous place along the line of said road, and two others at public places in the community, all in Freedom Township.

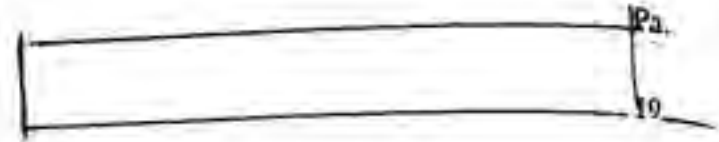
