Call to Order

Chair Young called the Board of Supervisor's Public Hearing to order at 6:45 PM.

Purpose of the Hearing

Zoning text amendment application from Mason Dixon Farms, Inc. to increase the maximum impervious lot coverage from 10% to 25% in the Agricultural Zoning District.

Mr. Gulden stated that the hearing was properly advertised in the Gettysburg Times, the County Planning Commission provided a review, and the Township's Planning Commission recommended approval of the application.

Board of Supervisor's Comment

Vice-Chair Kellett clarified that this amendment was requested by Mason Dixon Farms and not initiated by the Township. The change would affect all properties in the Agricultural Zoning District and not just Mason Dixon Farms.
