Mr. Gulden stated that the PC recommended approval of the plan, all waiver requests, and sewage planning module. Adams County did not submit comments; however, it is over the 30-day threshold, so they can act on the plan tonight.

Chair Young made a **MOTION** to approve waiving the requirement of a preliminary plan. The **MOTION** was **SECONDED** by Mr. Johnston. The motion carried unanimously (2-0).

Chair Young made a **MOTION** to deny waiving the requirement of adding a planting unit per lot (street tree). The **MOTION** was **SECONDED** by Mr. Johnston. The motion carried unanimously (2-0).

Chair Young made a **MOTION** to approve the sewage planning module. The **MOTION** was **SECONDED** by Mr. Johnston. The motion carried unanimously (2-0).

Chair Young made a **MOTION** to approve the Richard G. Gordon subdivision plan with the following conditions:

- 1. Add the approved waivers to the final plan.
- 2. Sewage facilities' planning approval is required.
- 3. An executed owner's acknowledgment is required.
- 4. A payment of recreation fee in lieu of land dedication is required.

The **MOTION** was **SECONDED** by Mr. Johnston. The motion carried unanimously (2-0).

B. Approval of an advertisement for the 2023 stone bids for consideration.
