APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- Spread and grade stones on Rorhbaugh and Gordon Roads. Total of 6 loads / approximate 100 tons hauled by Welty Backhoe Service from Speciality Granules.
- Cold patch repairs on Natural Dam, Chapman, and Wenschhof Roads.
- NESL Co. did the base repairs and culvert pipe replacements on Wenschhof, Middle Creek, Shorbs Mill, Chapman, and Natural Dam Roads. The Township supplied the culvert pipes.
- Replaced the street signs at intersection of Bullfrog Road and Emmitsburg Road.
- International truck state inspected at Dennis Rileys as Sanders stopped inspecting CDL trucks.

The land development plan was presented to the Township as a non-profit use. The outside sidewalks, driveway, parking area, and landscaping has been suspended. There will not be any public gatherings or public events of any sort. The personal use capacity would only include the owner of the property.
