**CALL TO ORDER**

**PURPOSE OF THE HEARING**

Mr. Gulden said the purpose of the public hearing is to inform and take public comment in regards to the proposed Ordinance 2018-03, which would repeal and replace Section 513 in the Freedom Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance. The Adams County and Freedom Township Planning Commissions have reviewed the proposed ordinance, provided comment, and recommended approval.
